Snow Removal Plan

2019

The following guidance is based on snow accumulating up to 2" and over 2". For snow that is accumulating up to 2" (as recorded at Reagan Airport), the contractor will clear all areas including building entrances, steps, landings, ramps, walkways, accessible entrances, emergency exits to maintain safe passage for access into the building.

If snow accumulates more than 2", the contractor will have snow plowed and/or shoveled into piles in pre-designated areas. If necessary, loaders will be used to scoop snow and load into dump trucks. Snow blowers will be utilized in all areas that are too small for plow trucks or loaders to access. Workers with shovels will be used to continuously clear snow from the building entrances, steps, emergency exits and accessible entrances.

(Priority 1) - Areas to be cleared 24 X 7:

- C Street entrance
- C Street sidewalk
- Ramp E
- Ramps A / B

(Priority 2) - Areas to be cleared on government work days prior to 6:00 a.m.

- Same as above
- E Street entrance
- E Street sidewalk
- Ramps C and D (18th Street) and G (19th Street)
- Ramp F (for Sodexo)
- Guard booths for all ramps
- All egress routes out of the MIB
- Path from South Penthouse to flag poles on the roof

(Priority 3) - Areas to be cleared on government work days ASAP after 6:00 a.m.

- MIB sidewalks on 18th and 19th Streets
- Balconies on the 6th floor

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Protocols for Security Guard Support during Inclement Weather

The contract guard force provides security at all times for the Main Interior Building. The security presence includes holidays and weekends. When inclement weather impacts the opening of the Federal Government or allows for early dismissals as stated by OPM, contract security must be present and on post.

Regardless of OPM's decision related to the Federal Government's status during inclement weather (e.g., government closure, 2 hour delayed opening, approved telework or administrative leave, etc.) the following guard posts will open on time and will adhere to the following schedule:

- A ramp: 6:00 a.m. opening
- D ramp: 6:00 a.m. opening
- E ramp: 6:00 a.m. opening
- G ramp: 6:00 a.m. opening
- C Street entrance: 24 hour accessible
- E Street entrance: 6:00 a.m. opening

Guard posts will remain open on a case-by-case basis. Decisions for systematic early post closures will be coordinated through the Director of the Office of Law Enforcement and Security (OLES).
